Squatter (Street) Children Ministry, Davao City, Philippines

In 2001, God put it on the heart of Marissa Guartico, a devoted Christian a deep love and concern for the souls of the squatter children, who with no homes of their own, squat on private and government properties , leaving quickly when they see the owner coming. These kids eat only 1 or 2 times a day. In September, 2003, God miraculously put me in contact with Marissa

Nobody comforted them until such time God allow us to minister there. You can hear them say they're hopeless and helpless. With that, I cannot afford to just listen, I promise to God and myself that i will do my best to open the minds of these kids that there is hope and future. God is faithful to us and the kids, though we struggled so much in the finances but again, we have this joy to minister to the kids. Every Saturday, when the kids see us going to their place, they all run to meet us

After hearing of this wonderful ministry and this great need for Cebuano Bibles, as the people there in these areas have no money for education to learn English, we sent Alex, one of our volunteer CDI workers for the past 2 years to check it out. He found the Marissa and the pastor and his wife at ULAS COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP to be wonderful Christians laborers with all of us in the Kingdom and the need was just as it was stated by Marissa, confirming what we felt in our hearts.

So we brought the need for Cebuano Bibles to the attention of our own wonderful fellowship , King's Christian Center about 3wks. Ago. Praise God! They responded in love and amazing generosity and by God's grace Alex was able to go with Marissa this past Wednesday and purchase 130 Bibles in the Cebuano Language, which they will gift to each family who is willing to have a regular Home Bible study with them. Bible distribution and Bilbe studies is scheduled to begin this Sat. Nov. 22. We expect to have pictures of the Bible distribution next issue. (The picture shows the children in only 1 of 5 squatter areas where Marissa and others minister.)

Gideon Amoako Sarpong, the 15 yr. old young man, who we are helping to complete his High School education, currently through distance learning via computer and our teaching assistance and curriculum provided through CDI, has successfully arrived in Switzerland, after his visa to the USA failed to materialize. He is doing very well in his studies, even though we had to postpone his lessons for two weeks of readjustment time, trying to locate a computer he could use for the classes he has on CD ROMs, etc. Today, Nov. 14, 2003 we got the exciting news from him, that God has provided him with a computer to use for his edu-

cation. This gift was provided for Gideon by some local Swiss people, who obviously have their hearts open to share the goodness of the Lord. It is currently in the Dutch language, so Gideon is working now to reformat it into English, so it will accept the CD ROMs we sent to him in English for his various subjects. We

Alex Catiero, one of several CDI workers in the Philippines, played a very important role in the Crusade there this past week. He helps in any way he can. Hundreds of people participated in this Crusade and heard the Gospel of Jesus. The results were



very good as God did his work in the hearts of the people who attended.

Also, we've been praying that Alex could come here for a few months for extra training and to help with some of the things we've gotten behind on, but his visa to the USA was also denied on June 20, 2003. A week before his interview at the Embassy in Manila, he was hired for a job, as a professor at the Philippine College of Technology. We had prayed for

him to get a job for over a year, but although he tried hard, jobs are very hard to get there. So he was happy to have the job. However, the agreed on salary of @\$174 USD a month, has not been honored, and he was only given the equiv. Of \$20 USD for the entire month, 4 hours in class hours and more than that in out of class work, since all the classes are new. Please pray for a good job for Alex. He is so tired.

The doctors had written him off for dead. They had given no hope, but God stepped in and changed all that. Curtis and Rachel say THANKS again. Keep praying for God to take care of all the bills, continue to give strength to Rachel, and for their 5 young children.
