Squatter (Street) Children's Ministry, Davao City, Philippines

In 2001, God put it on the heart of Marissa Guartico, (a devoted Christian), a deep love and concern for the souls of the squatter children, who with no real homes of their own, squat on private and government properties, leaving quickly when they see the owner coming. These kids eat only 1 or 2 times a day. Here is the need, as stated by Marissa, "My desire and prayer is that each family must have a Bible. All of the kids we minister to are non-believers and don't have Bibles."



Gideon Amoako Sarpong, the 15 yr. old young man, prepraring to become a pastor/doctor, who we are helping to complete his High School education, currently through distance learning, has successfully arrived in Switzerland, after his visa to the USA failed to materialize. His natural father died a few months ago, and his mom and step dad live in Switzerland. He is doing very well in his studies, even though we had to postpone his lessons for two weeks of readjustment time, trying to locate a computer he could use for the classes he has on CD ROMs, etc. Nov. 14, 2003, we got the exciting news from him, that God has provided him with a computer to use for his education. This gift was provided by some local Swiss people, who obviously have their hearts open to share the goodness of the Lord. The computer is in the Dutch language, so Gideon is working now to reformat it into English, so it will accept the CD ROMs we sent to him in English for his various High School courses. We praise God for his faithfulness.

Story of Nagamani, 13 yrs. Old, Good Shepherd's Children's Home

When Hayagreev Suri, a 26 yr. old man who loves the Lord and children, was coming home from service one night about 11 PM, he saw Nagamani, sitting and crying at the bus stand. Being concerned, he talked to her, but she was afraid to talk to him, until she saw one of the orphans which Hayagreev cares for in his rented house, with him and she recognized him from school.. Finally, Nagamani told her story.

She had been working as a servant at the house of a very rich family. This family has 2 boys who are grown, (18 yrs.) Both parents worked and one of the boys went to college. The other boy would "stay home for some work", then go after Nagamani to molest and

and rape her. Day after day he would do this. Finally, in desperation she told the boy's parents about it, but the mother said, "We can't do anything about that." So when the boy's parents left again for some occasion, Nagamani ran from the boy, to the bus station to cry and try to get away from him. Hayagreev, with the help of the orphan he had with him at the time, was finally able to convince Nagamani that he would not harm her, but would give her a home to stay in, so Nagamani came to live at The Good Shepherd Children's Home that day. Nagamani is only 1 of 40 children, each with their own tragic stories. Many have no living parents, and others, like Nagamani were given to abusive families as slaves, so their natural parents would not have to care for them.
