MINISTRY TEAM IN CAGAYAN DE ORO, PHILIP-

The Lord has been doing mighty things in Cagayan de Oro, despite the financial crisis he and his family are going through, according to Sam's exciting report. God enabled them to host 2 major concerts of STEVE KUBAN the singer and song writer of the songs 'The Lord is My Tower,' 'Welcome Holy Spirit', 'I Lift Your Name on High', and many more. The 1st concert at Ozamiz City, November 27, 2005 was attended by +/- 6,000 people. At least 2,000 of them accepted Jesus that night. The presence of God was awesome! People just moved forward and accepted Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior. There were also backsliders who renewed their faith and commitment to the Lord. The 2nd was at Lanao Del Norte, a Muslim area, on Dec 4, 2005. The capacity of the gym is 10,000 people but we printed only 7,000 tickets, all the tickets were sold. To God be the Glory!!!!!! When Pastor Steve Kuban

challenged the audience to accept our Lord Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior, people just left their seats and went forward. People from the balcony came rushing down to the front. "You should have been here to witness it all," Sam told us. The mighty hand of God was moving in a tremendous way. People wept and just felt the presence and the Love of Jesus Christ. Even the military personnel who were guarding us accepted our Lord Jesus Christ. You will see it all in the pictures."

A 3rd concert was held Feb. 12, 2006. It was attended by 600 +/- people, including at least 50 pastors (an answer to much prayer for unity of the body of Christ). At least 90 people accepted Jesus that night.

Over 2 years ago, Engin and Nurcan answered the call of God to start a church in Bodrum, the former area of Biblical Ephesus, where there was NO church in the whole town. They are often in danger from the authorities and are taken to the police stations often for questioning. Many of you will remember that last year the police nailed the church door shut with a spike and a note serving them notice that they could no longer have church. By that time, after much prayer and work, they had developed a core of 12-20 believers. Isn't it amazing how those who serve satan saw them as such a threat in a big city?

A few years ago they were made keenly aware of the awesome power of the media to let people know about Jesus, but there was no Turkish Christian television channel in Turkey. It is not allowed in Turkey. But that event put a dream in their hearts for a Turkish television program and they and their small congregation began praying for this. God has answered that prayer and the **first** Turkish Christian TV broadcast aired on Jan. 10, 2006 from a Greek island not far from Turkey. Please pray that the people who watch this channel will be encouraged and hear the Word of God. Also pray for Turkish people to get saved through this Christian channel. Pastor Engin says, "Thank you for your prayers and joining our happiness." for this ministry. We praise God! Nothing is impossible with Him!

Ptr. Engin is very creative in bringing the Good News to the Turkish people. We praise God for his boldness, always making the most of every opportunity. Nepal, Arjun and Shobha


As most of you know, Arjun and Shobha have turned their own rental house into a loving home for orphaned Nepalese children. They currently have 7 they are caring for and raising as their own, teaching them daily the love of Jesus in action, teaching them the Word of God and giving them the special love of a mother and father and family. Their children's home is called Gentle Hearts Children's Home. Recently, God has blessed us with some faithful supporters of this wonderful ministry. We praise God for every person who has heard God speaking to help them have food, clothes and education for these precious children.

Nepal, Dhan and Phebe

Dhan works faithfully in a local church body in Kathmandu, as well as planting new churches in all different areas of Nepal. He travels to places by foot for miles and miles over rugged terrain to reach people in very remote villages with the Gospel of Jesus. He recently returned to Nepal after a year of ministry training at Christ for the Nations Institute in Dallas, TX, where we had the opportunity to spend several hours with him and share a meal together.



He is now prepared to carry on the rest of the vision God has put on his and Phebe's hearts to care for and love orphan children, which are everywhere in Nepal, training them in the ways of the Lord, letting them see his love in action, as well as helping adults learn life skills to get them out of their poverty and forced servitude to abusive Muslim or Hindu masters.





Deepak and Jenny started a ministry in Pokhara called New Life Ministries February 14, 2005 and God has been moving mightily through them caring for the poor, for refugees running for their lives, the elderly, widows, and providing school for very poor children. They also have a dream to have a Children's Home for some of the many orphans left from the past war torn years. God is indeed raising up his people to work in His Harvest.

God is also using both Deepak and Jenny in a healing ministry which has been made evident in several recent events including praying for healing for a sister in the Lord diagnosed with cervical cancer that was spreading rapidly to other parts of her body. Deepak made the decision to obey God and believe completely in the Doctor of doctors, rather than believe in the diagnosis of the worldly doctor. In answer to that prayer after 4 days the lady was taken to the same hospital and examined by the same people and doctor, but they did not find any clue of cancer. God shows Himself mighty when we trust in Him. Deepak was greatly encouraged and is telling all around him the Good News of Jesus' love, even though they live in a

restricted country. God continues to miraculously protect them from bombings, faulty construction of the hospital where Jenny works, severe illness, etc. as they trust God completely and take Him at His Word. Satan has often tried to take their lives and get them distracted from God's work, but they continue to plant new churches, feed the hungry, share their clothes with those who have none, etc.

Nepal, Pastor Sundar

In July,2005, Sundar's heart began to compel him to reach the lost Muslims (99%) in the small village of Sitapaila outside Kathmandu(capital city), where God had moved him to through circumstances.

In faith, he acted on that belief, and began visiting people in their homes, inviting them to his home for fellowship and prayer meeting. He also started praying and believing God for people to respond to God's love and Word and accept Jesus as their Savior. God honored his faith in action and in only a few weeks, 15-16 people were coming to hear Sundar share God's Word.

Now, only 7 months later, 20-25 people are attending regularly and most of those have gotten saved. Sundar works as a part-time teacher to support himself and ministry, however his small income does not cover all the costs of this growing ministry, which includes caring for the poor he encounters as well. Please



join with us in prayer that God will provide his monthly rent of a place to meet of \$60/month. He is also in need of 1 motorbike (\$1500) and 2 mountain bicycles (\$230) for transportation to reach the people, since some new converts are willing to help him reach the others.

Zachariah (Zaq) Kamau., Kenya

Zaq works as an evangelist/ teacher with Africa Gospel Ministry On Time [AGMOT-Kenya]. This is a ministry he started with the help of two devoted brothers. He is also leading a child mercy program within this ministry, which is dedicated to help poor des-

perate children, not for riches, but to help them meet their basic needs- food, clothing and education. They have already taken 15 children, most of whom are orphans and single parent kids. Currently, they are looking for Christians who are willing to "adopt" them by helping them have their basic needs met. If any of you are interested in sponsoring 1 or more of these children, please let us know and we'll get that set up with AGMOT-Kenya.

Mike and I (Londa) and family are very excited that God has miraculously opened the door for Zaq to get a work visa to the USA. This will enable him to get a job once he arrives in the states and settles in our home. Then he can use the money to cover his needs and send the rest to AGMOT to sustain the ministry



there. We expect him to arrive the end of April or beginning of May. Please pray with us that all continues to work smoothly and for \Zaq's adjustment to our home and America.
