Brother Richard in Uganda Recovering From Near Fatal Accident

Mokono, Uganda For over two long years, Richard Sempala, our LIFE Aid Foundation representative in Uganda and founder of AFRICA LIFE YOUTH FOUNDATION has been suffering from an unknown illness that has been racking his body with pain. Despite this "thorn in his flesh" and the many near deaths he's experienced from extreme malaria and vindictive poisoning of his body, he has held to God's promises and followed after Him, believing that God does remember Him and He has a purpose in all of this. Richard has been a faithful minister of the Gospel to the hurting and desperate refugees pouring into Uganda and to the unreached people of remote villages in his general area. He regularly goes with out meals, at which time He chooses to pray, believing if he has no food to eat, then God wants him to pray. He totally feels the needs of the street children since both his natural parents died when he was a young child, his father due to actually fighting in the war and his mother due to an illness caused by malnutrition during the war period. As a street child growing up fighting for his very life, he learned the hurts they endure and God developed a great compassion for them in his heart. Satan has tried and tried to tear down Richard's ministry by destroying him, yet God continues to preserve His life for a greater purpose.

On August 7, 2007, Richard again had a close brush with death, as the taxi he was riding in went out of control killing most of the passengers. Richard miraculously survived, truly a miracle of God. He lost much blood, and was in critical condition in the hospital for quite some time, both legs were broken, one in 4 places severely enough to needs surgery and pins. As soon as we at LAF were notified of the accident, we started praying for Richard and asked our local body of believers and other representatives to pray. God, in



His awesome mercy has heard our prayers and by the end of October, 2007, Richard is now out of the hospital and practicing walking with a crutch. What an awesome God we serve. The doctors would not give Richard the medical care he needed with out knowing the bill would be covered. We praise God for providing the needed money to cover the hospital bill right at the time it was needed, but not a moment too soon. God knew all about this accident before it happened and we give Him all the glory.
