After MANY months of hard work and many papers submitted to IRS, on December 13, 2007, we were granted that status. This means that we are now able to accept checks for Freedom's Hope Ministry, Inc. and if you choose, you may claim a tax exemption for any donations you make to either Freedom's Hope Ministry, Inc. or LIFE Aid Foundation. Both are doing essentially the same type of ministry efforts, but LAF is still a project of Vision Ministry, Inc., so all ministry donations sent to P.O. Box 1886, Bonners Ferry, ID 83805 will be sent to Vision Ministry, Inc. first and put in our LAF account with them, and we request the disbursement to go where you request or where it is needed most at the time depending on what you request. This does take extra time to get to the need and some needs are urgent, which is why Freedom's Hope Ministry is so important.

At LIFE Aid Foundation, we endeavor to follow the guidelines found in Matthew 25:35, 36 & 40 (NIV) where Jesus said, "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me....The King will reply, ' I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.'"

Isaiah 58:6-9 (NIV)

"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen; to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter—when you see the naked, to clothe him, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood? **Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear; then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the Lord will be your rear guard. Then you will call, and the Lord will answer; you will cry for help, and he will say: Here am I.**"

We desperately need to help get food to these precious orphan children in Nepal, India, Tanzania, Uganda, and Kenya.

PLEASE pray about how you can help, so they won't starve to death. Thank you!

We have been notified by many of the indigenous ministers we serve, that due to severe weather conditions in their area, the majority of the crops (rice and vegetables) have been destroyed making the cost of feeding the children in their children's homes more than they can do. In India many of the children, even those in their children's homes have had to go without meals. Even their staple food of rice is costing more than they can afford. These precious brothers and sisters in the Lord do not want to have the children go back to the streets from where they came, with no hope. PLEASE pray diligently for these precious children who have already lost the love and nurturing of a parent and have only tasted of love and security after coming to the Children's Home where they live. These include children we have been supporting regularly every month and many that we are only able to help some of the time. Even those we regularly support are not able to have all the food their growing bodies truly need, due to the higher food costs, making what we are able to send not go far enough.
